User Guide – Players

1. Steps for Player seeking to Transfer

A. Give Club Secretary details

- Contact the Secretary of the Club you wish to join and give him/her the following details:
- Your personal e-mail address.
 - Name of the Club and County you wish to leave.

B. Club Secretary will access the Player Transfer System

- The Club Secretary will then log in to the Player Transfer System and send an online transfer application to you.

C. Player makes Online Application

- You will receive an e-mail entitled 'Inter-County Transfer Application'.
→ Please check the junk and spam folders in your e-mail account.

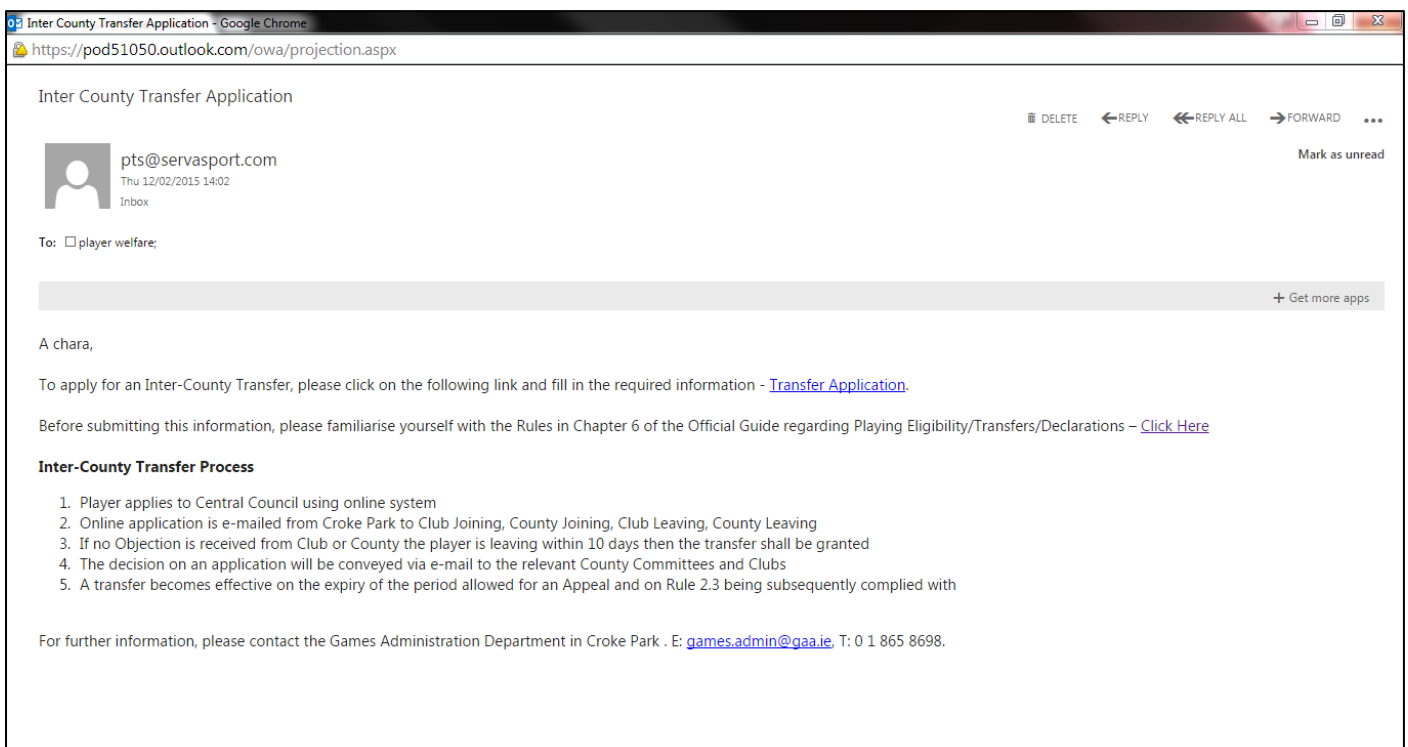


Figure 1 E-mail to player entitled 'Inter-County Transfer Application'



GAA Player Transfer - Player Details Saved

Thank you for updating your details.

- Your transfer has been sent to the Secretary of the Club you wish to join to approve and send to the Games Administration Department in Croke Park for processing
- The GAA will then seek approval from the County you wish to join, the Club you wish to leave and the County you wish to leave.
- If no Objection is received from Club or County the player is leaving within 10 days then the transfer shall be granted
- The GAA can grant the transfer as soon as all Secretaries have approved the application
- The decision on an application will be conveyed via e-mail to the relevant County Committees and Clubs
- At the earliest, a player cannot play for **six days** after a transfer is granted in Croke Park. Once both County Committees are notified of a decision on a transfer application by Croke Park, there is a three day period for an Appeal. This period must expire and cannot be expedited. On the expiry of these three days, a player can be registered by his Club and the transfer becomes effective.
- In addition, all players must be registered three days before a game. It is important to note that an applicant for a Transfer cannot apply for registration until after the time for an appeal against such transfer has elapsed or any such appeal has been determined (R. 6.6 (j), T.O. 2014).

Please refer all correspondence on your application to your Club Secretary.

Once you click submit, you will receive a summary of the next steps. No further action is required from you (If details are accurate).

D. Club reviews Application and submits to Central/Provincial Council

- The Club you wish to join will be alerted to the fact that you've submitted your details.
- If inaccuracies are noted, the Club can seek an amendment from you.
- Once the Club is satisfied that your details are correct, the application will be sent to Central Council for processing.

E. Central/Provincial Council processes Application

- If all of the information appears to be in order, Central Council will forward the application to all parties for consideration
- The Club you are leaving and both Counties will receive an e-mail from Central Council and can either 'Accept' or 'Object' the application within 10 days.

F. Notification of Decision

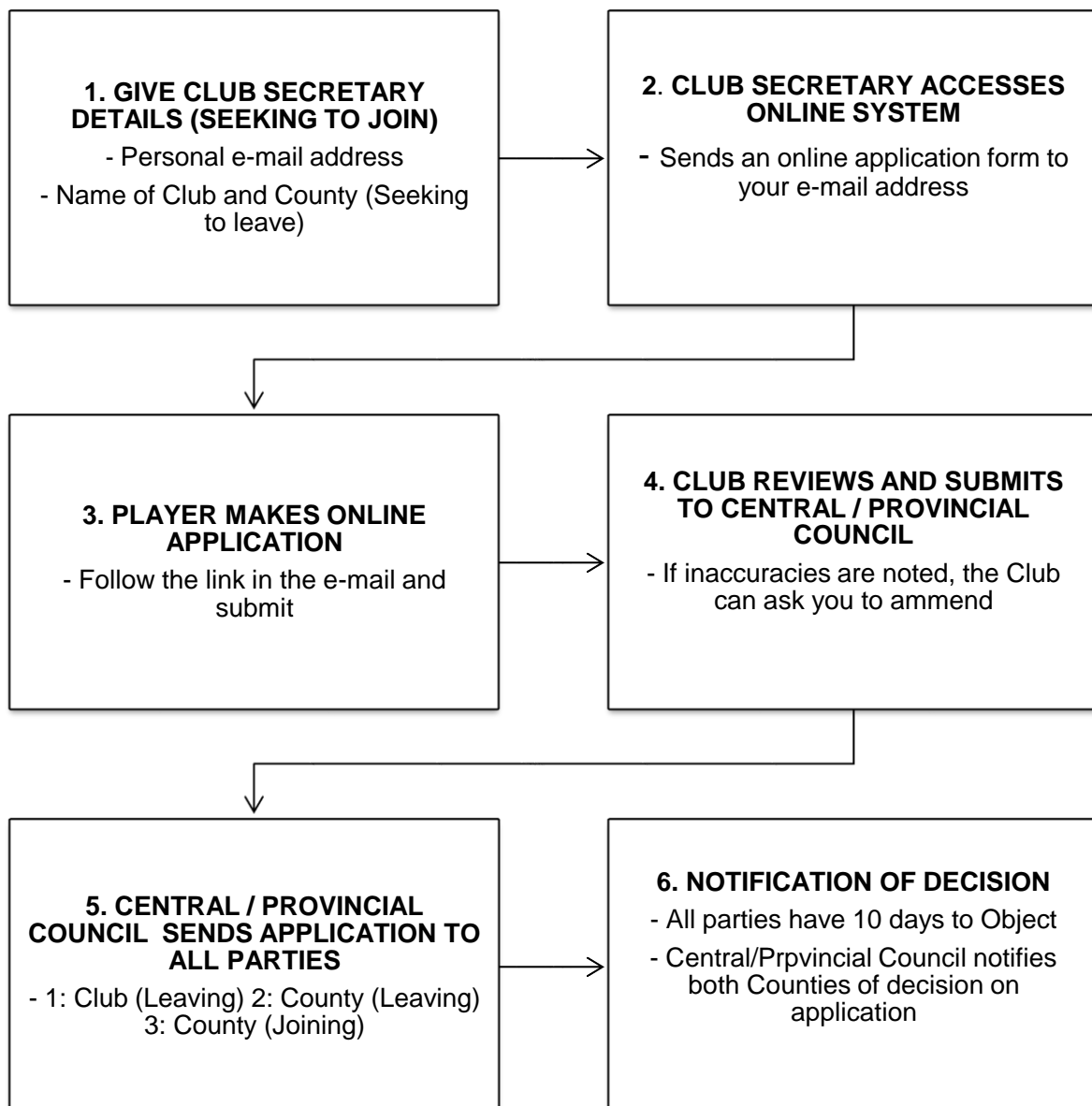
Both County and Club Secretaries will be notified when a decision has been made.

2. Playing for New Club

- At the earliest, a player cannot play for **six days** after a transfer is granted in Croke Park/Provincial Officer.
- Once both County Committees are notified of a decision on a transfer application by Central Council, there is a three day period for an Appeal. This period must expire and cannot be expedited. On the expiry of these three days, a player can be registered by his Club and the transfer becomes effective.

- All players must be registered three days before a game.
- It is important to note that a player cannot apply for registration until after the time for an Appeal against such transfer has elapsed.
